

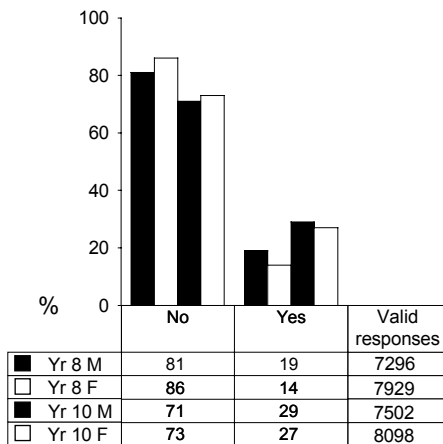
Regular work

Around 28% of the Year 10 pupils have regular paid work

Have you a regular paid job during term time?

Respondents with more than one job were asked to record the one that paid the most money.

- Up to 19% of 12-13 year olds have a regular paid job during term time.
- By the time they are 14-15 years old, around 28% of pupils report having a regular paid job.



Comments

- The chart below shows data from 1987 of those pupils who report having a regular paid job in term time. The percentages, for the 14-15 year old pupils, show a general downward trend. Figures from the 12-13 year olds remained consistent over the 1990s, then rose slightly and now appear to be declining.
